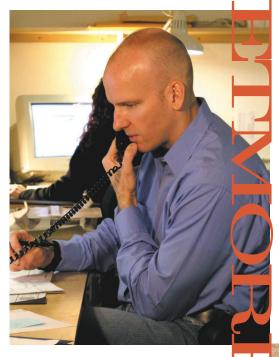
American literature and language, and resides in New York City.
